About the Role

[Street Feast](#) is Ireland's national weekend of neighbourhood street parties and food sharing. It is an initiative of [Neighbourhood Network](#), a not-for-profit, community building organisation. We're all about building and strengthening neighbourhoods and kick-starting ideas for positive community participation. Our goal for Street Feast this year is to inspire 1250 Street Feasts to take place across the country on the weekend of 24th/25th May.

As a Campaign Officer, you will support the Campaign Manager in carrying out all aspects of the Street Feast 2025 campaign from start to finish. You will also work closely with the Street Feast Campaign Community Officer.

About Neighbourhood Network

Neighbourhood Network is a registered Irish charity (RCN: 20206679) which aims to promote social inclusion, tackle loneliness and build supportive and resilient neighbourhoods around Ireland. The ambition is simple; to help create happy, healthy and more connected places for people to live, where neighbours feel supported by each other. - Street Feast Volunteer recruitment, induction, and coordination
- Promotional roadshow events and Street Feast Together coordination support
- Attending several Roadshows where applicable
- Creation of annual reports following Street Feast
- Working successfully alongside the seasonal Street Feast team
